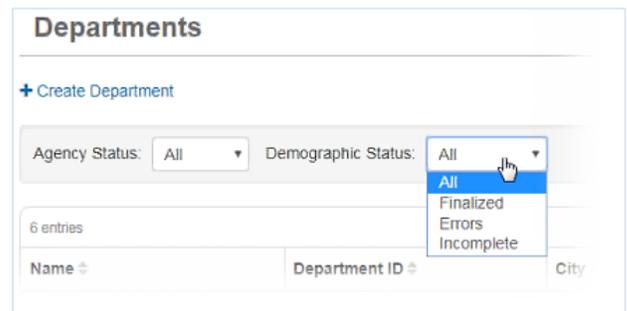

Administration

New Advanced Search and Export for the Departments Tab

From the **Administration: Departments** tab, an Advanced Search toolbar is now available. This search feature can help you quickly locate a particular agency, agency status, and more.

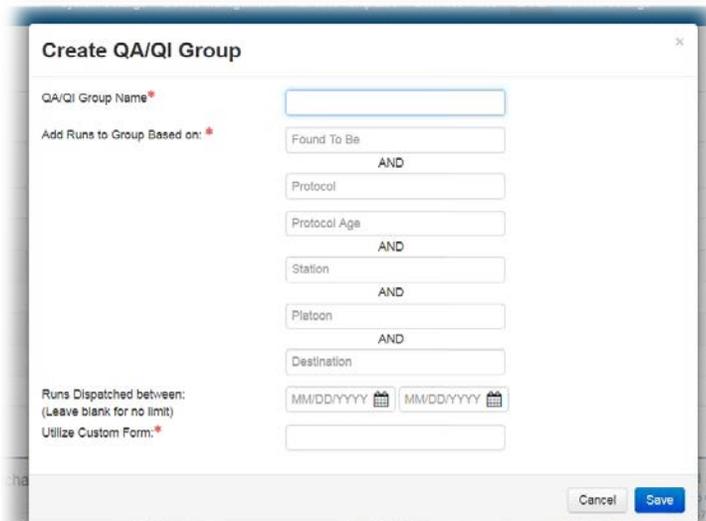
Additionally, a new **Export** option under the **Actions** drop-down menu allows you to readily export data from the table if needed.



New QA/QI Groups

The **QA/QI Forms** tab has become the **QA/QI** tab with two subtabs: **Forms** and **Groups**. The new **Groups** tab allows you to create QA/QI groups, of which can be useful for managing subsets of runs with specific criteria.

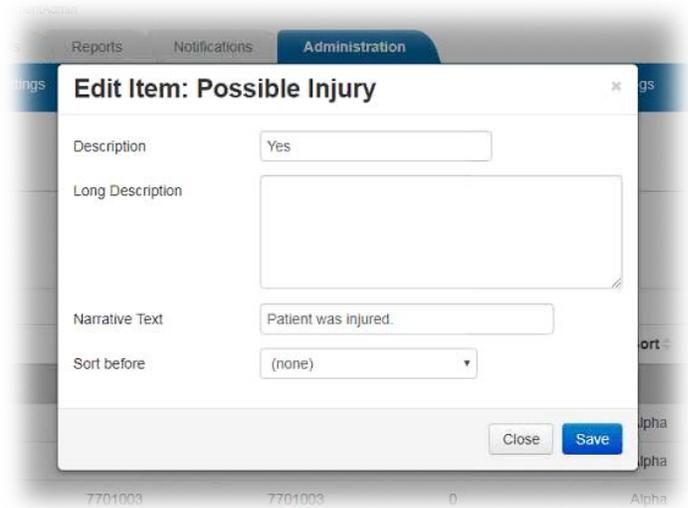
Department administrators can use groups and define not only what custom form to utilize for run records categorized into a group, but also what runs belong in the group according to **Found To Be, Protocol, Protocol Age, Station, Platoon, and Destination** values.



Enabled Customization of Narrative Text for Pick List Items

To help make automatically inserted narrative text more readable and accessible, the option now exists to customize the text that is entered in the narrative based on pick list items selected by the user.

For example, if a user selects **Yes** for **Possible Injury**, custom text that would appear in the narrative, instead of simply **Yes**, could read “Patient was injured.”

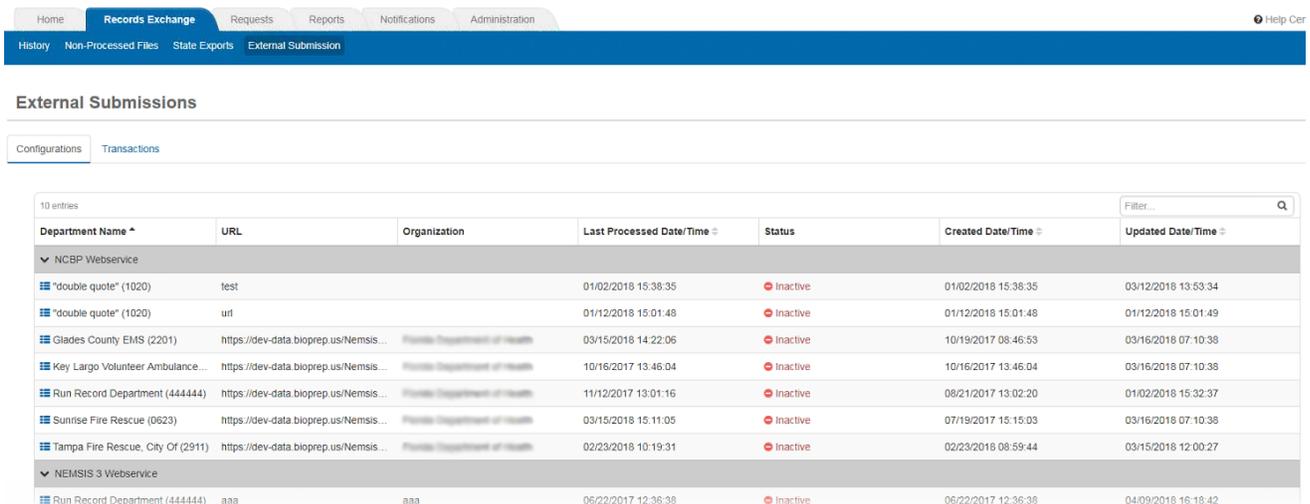


Added Export Options for Grids

You can now export the list of run records in the tables found on the **Recent Records**, **Incomplete Runs**, **Complete Runs**, **Pending Review**, **Complications**, **Addendum**, **Validation Errors**, and **Finalized Runs** landing pages. This option allows you to get a comprehensive look at how many records are in a specific status and take any appropriate action accordingly.

Enhanced External Submissions UI

DOH Administrators can now access external submissions by going to the **Records Exchange: External Submission** tab.

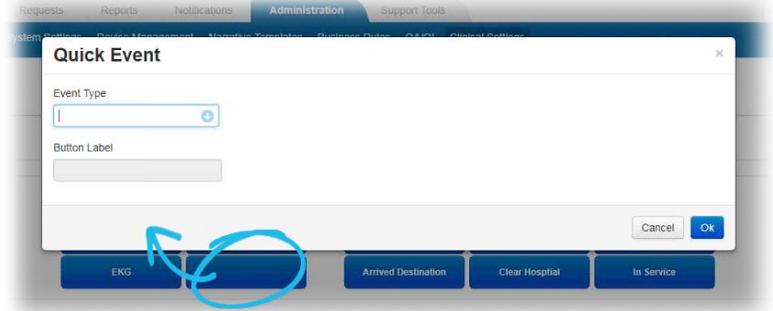

Two subtabs, **Configurations** and **Transactions**, give further access to specific external submissions only. For example, via the **Configurations** tab, administrators can only view NCBP Webservice and NEMSIS 3 Webservice external submissions, and configurations cannot be edited. Instead, when clicking on a submission, the **Transactions** tab opens

Made Quick Events Configurable

By going to **Administration: Clinical Settings**, you can access the **Quick Events** subtab and configure the quick **Event** buttons that appear at the top of the run record when a user completes a run record in TripTix Windows.



Added Elements to the Run Summary's Access History Section

External submissions are now visible in the Run Summary's *Access History* section, indicating when a transfer was completed and to which webservice.

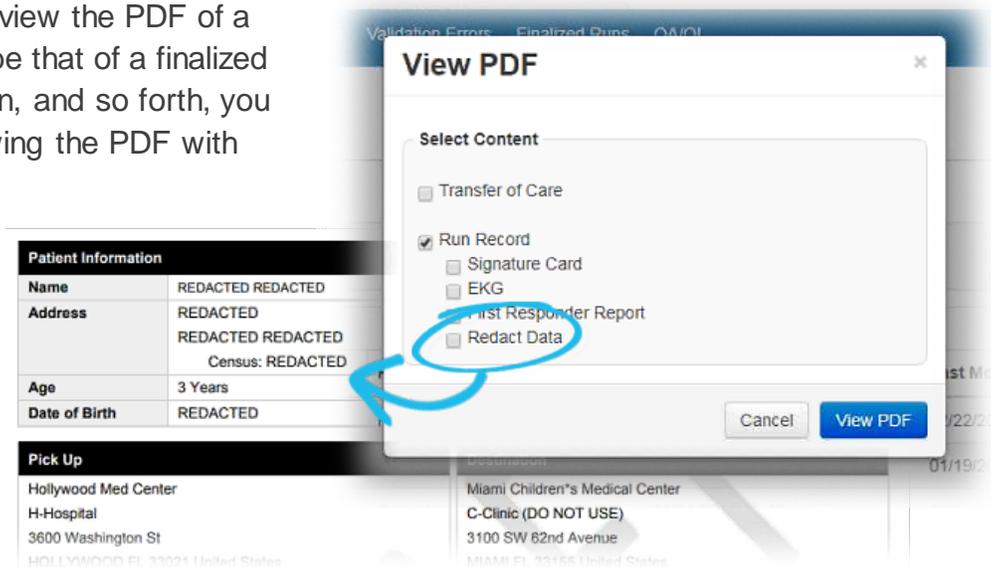

Additionally, the *Access History* section further denotes when a finalized run successfully created an account in EMR. This transparency allows you to ensure a billing account was created and that the run record will be processed through the billing system for reimbursement.

Introduced Redact Data Option for Run Record PDFs

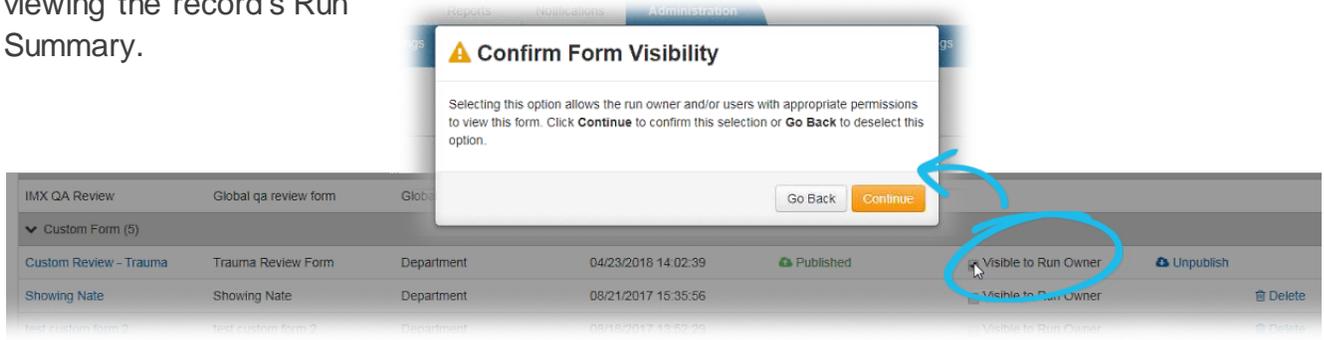
Any time you select to view the PDF of a run record, whether it be that of a finalized run, prior to faxing a run, and so forth, you have the option of viewing the PDF with redacted information.

This PDF de-identifies particular information, including a patient's personal demographics data. You'll note that same data points are redacted as seen in the Peer Review version of a run record's PDF.



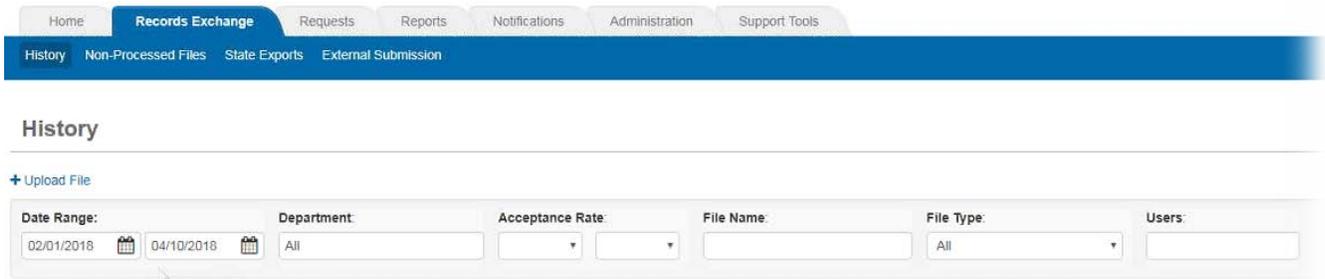
Enabled Selection of Custom Form Visibility

Administrators have the ability to choose whether a custom form is visible to the run owner. By going to **Administration: QA/QI**, owners can select the visibility check box and allow run owners, and those with the proper permissions, to view the custom run review forms when viewing the record's Run Summary.



Updated the Records Exchange Tab

An Advanced Search toolbar allows you to quickly locate a particular run record using a date picker, a user's name, a user's username, and more.

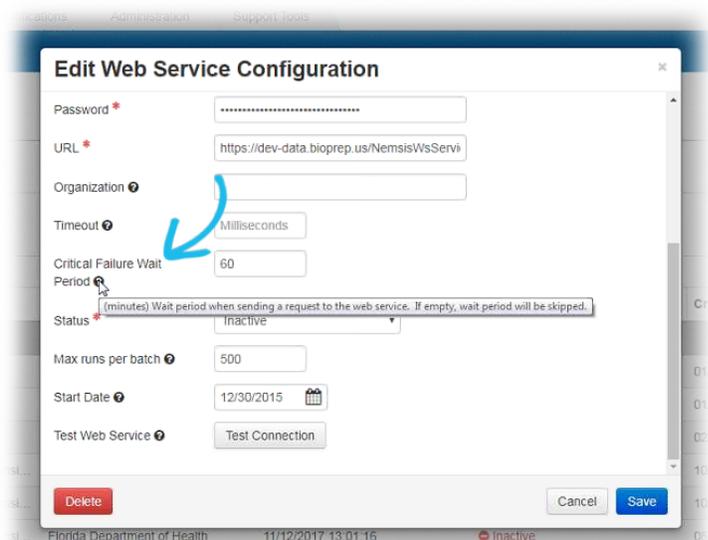


If you are a DOH Administrator with the proper access, the user's name becomes a clickable hyperlink in the table and will take you to an in-depth look at that user's profile information.

Improved Web Service Configuration

Editing a Web Service configuration is easier than ever and includes a new **Critical Failure Wait Period** field.

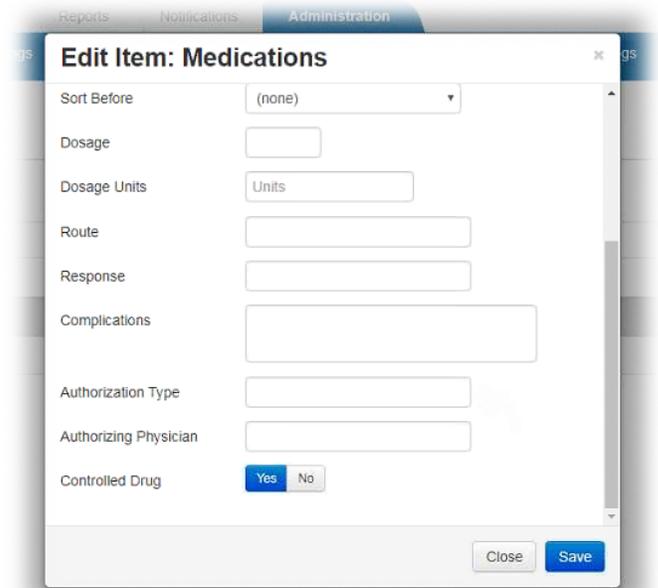
This field can be used to set how long the system will wait before attempting to send data again.



New Controlled Drug Field for Medication Pick List Items

When creating or modifying a medication pick list item, a new option allows you to set whether the medication is a controlled drug or not.

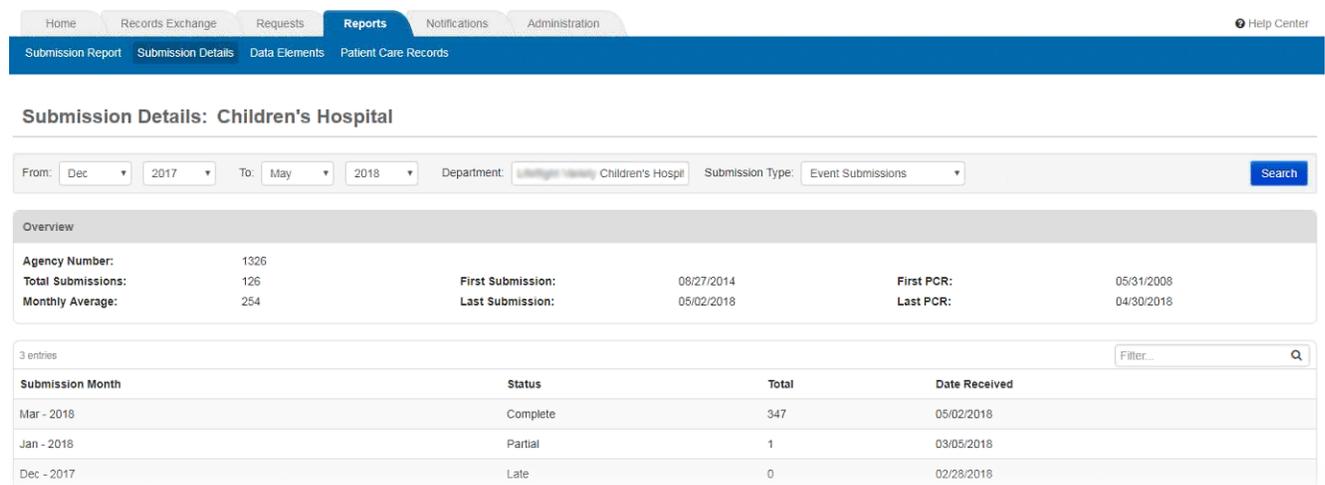
If **Yes**, when an individual selects this medication from the pick list in which it appears, the controlled drug form will become available in TripTix Windows. This automatic inclusion helps ensure providers know when they delivered a controlled drug and must complete the associated form for full compliance.



Updated Submissions Reports Subtab

The **Submission Reports** subtab has been updated to display, by default, submissions within a six month period. This extension from three to six months allows administrators to see a wider range of reports at a time.

Additionally, a new **Submission Details** subtab provides a designated section to view a specific department's submissions details without having to navigate through the **Submission Reports** table. When accessing this tab, you can filter details by a specific date range, department, and submissions type. Results will display data according to the searched criteria, including the selected agency's total submissions, monthly average, first submission date, last submission date, and more.

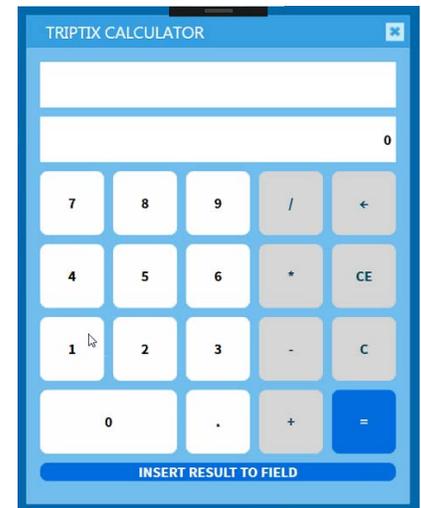
New Keep a Local Copy Option for Transfers

When transferring a run record from one mobile device to another, users can now choose to keep a local copy of the run record.



Added a Calculator for Computations

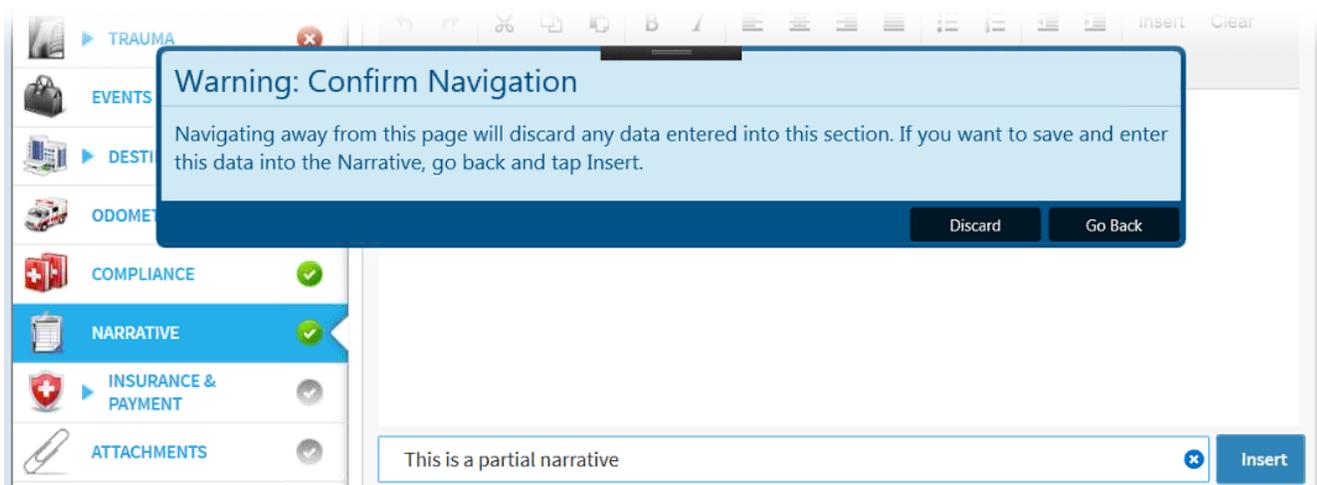
Calculating medication dosages and drip rates has been made easier by the inclusion of a custom Calculator within TripTix. This calculator can be accessed from the *Tools* menu, and calculations made with this tool can be inserted directly into the desired field.



Improved Narrative Entry Fields

In an effort to further improve the narrative entry fields, the field itself is now larger and responsive when viewing TripTix in differently sized window. This change keeps the window readily readable no matter the viewing format.

In addition, a prompt now alerts users that text entered into the **Insert** field for the narrative will be deleted unless this text is actually inserted into the narrative itself. This change helps to avoid discarded data when a user attempts to navigate away from the *Narrative* section without inputting typed text into the narrative.



Modified Session Timeout Logic

If you switch departments within which you are working, your timeout session updates to that of the current department's session timeout setting.

When there are automatic timeout settings configured by both the state and department, TripTix adheres to the strictest configured security settings.

Added Option to Indicate High or Low for Blood Sugar

For departments whose glucometers have a maximum or minimum digital read out (typically 600 and 20 respectively), the option now exists to simply indicate if the blood glucose reading was high or low. Entering H or L for BGL includes this reading in the mini narrative and allows the values to be exported to the state or NEMSIS as either 600 or 20.
